

Troubleshooting Problems When Printing PDF documents

If graphs/images print incorrectly when printing PDF format or if some pages are black, do the following recommended solution(s) from Adobe Support:

1. Print the PDF file as an image.

Printing the PDF file as an image may enable the file to print, but it doesn't identify the source of the problem [see link at bottom for further solutions from Adobe].

Note: When you print a PDF file as an image, it may take longer to print.

To print a PDF file as an image:

- Choose File > Print, and then click Advanced.
- Select Print As Image and any other desired printing options.
- Click OK to close the Advanced Print Setup dialog box, and then click OK.

2. Save the PDF file as a new file to your computer.

Resave the document by choosing File > Save As, and giving the file a new name. The Save As command causes Acrobat to rewrite the file.

3. Upgrade Adobe Reader to current version:
