Transitions to Post-Secondary Education and Employment Program

The Transition to Post-Secondary Education and Employment Program serves adults with a diagnosed learning disability and/or ADHD.

Purpose: to provide necessary skills and strategies development to become independent learners in a post-secondary or employment setting.

Course length: Post-Secondary Education and Employment is a 10 month bridging program beginning mid-August and ending in June, intake is continuous. Early applications for August enrollment are appreciated.

Intake: Continuous

Prerequisites: Grade 12 or equivalent, a completed diagnosis (LD or ADHD), and a written career development plan.

Funding: Tuition and materials may be provided by Workforce Development for Persons with Disabilities (WDPD).

The application process for Transition to Post-Secondary & Employment is separate from SIAST; therefore, it requires a separate and unique process. Please complete the following application.
